New Innovations Updates

The ACGME has been reviewing the common program requirements since October of 2015, and recently published their findings in a letter to the community from Chief Executive Officer Thomas J. Nasca, MD, MACP.

Included in the proposed changes are substantial modifications to the existing duty hour regulations, not the least of which is changing the name from "Duty Hours" to "Clinical Experience and Education."

Summary

- The duty hour rules are set to change significantly for the upcoming Academic Year
- The term "duty hours" is being abandoned for "clinical experience and education"
- There are proposed modifications to the short break rule, intern shift restriction, night float rule, and accounting for at home time

It is likely that many of the proposed changes will be approved and become effective in July of 2017. New Innovations is keeping an eye on the situation and will enact the changes as quickly as they can once they are approved.


