

Readily Accessible Naloxone at Discharge from ED

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Naloxone is a lifesaving medication that should be given to all patients who present to the Emergency Department with an opioid use related chief complaint. Often this medication is overlooked when discharging a patient or the patient leaves without going to the pharmacy to fill this medication. Our goal is to integrate an EPIC (Verona, WI) pop-up notification to alert and remind all providers who are the primary provider for patients with an opioid use disorder related complaint to order naloxone for discharge early in the patients ED course so the prescription can be readily available at the time of discharge. Our test of change would be the rate of naloxone prescriptions filled before and after the implementation of this tool.
