New Innovations Updates

GME Updates Coming: Clinical Experience and Education Module (formerly Duty Hours)

Last month at the ACGME Annual Educational Conference updates to Section VI of the Common Program Requirements were announced. While most of the changes proposed by the Task Force and shared with the community last fall were approved, there were several minor alterations, including a fragment of the Short Break rule.

The New Innovations team is actively reviewing the new requirements and has begun integrating the changes. They anticipate the necessary modifications will be available for your program by the July 1, 2017 deadline.

As a first step, they will be removing the 2003 rules configuration immediately. Be assured that any past violations / data will be preserved.

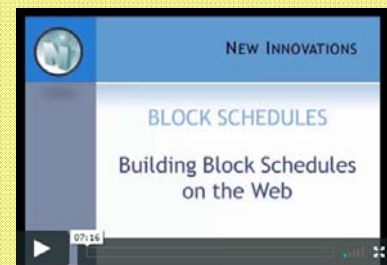
