## 2021-2022 Academic Year **Block Schedule Deadline**

The new academic year is just a few months away. Timely, accurate block schedule entry is important because:

- tiered deadlines ensure all trainees are effectively onboarded at their sites
- trainees are able to start their rotations as quickly as possible; and
- our hospital partners and programs have accurate and punctual data for funding and billing.

#### <u>Please review the block schedule deadlines below:</u>

#### May 1st:

- First quarter 2021-2022 RMS block schedules due
- Sites run reports to gather names of trainees to begin the onboarding process

#### June 1st:

- Second deadline for first quarter 2021-2022 RMS block schedule entry
- Sites will run reports to pull any trainees that were added between 5/1 and 6/1

#### After June 1st:

• Coordinators are responsible for directly contacting appropriate site coordinators if there are changes to the RMS block schedule to ensure this information is received/processed by the site
