Block Schedules & Gaps

RMS Block Schedules and Duty Hour logs must be updated, approved, and accurate through the last day of the month. FTE reports are generated on the 5th working day of the following month (ie. July FTE report will be generated on Friday, August 6th). Programs on duty hour protocol, please follow up with your residents and fellows to ensure that they enter and approve all RMS Duty Hour log entries by the deadline.

Naming Standards & Required Documentation

The standards streamline trainee rotations and documentation for hospital onboarding with the goal of reducing redundancies and administrative burden on program administrators, program/site coordinators and trainees. Each ensures programs and hospitals are entering required data and documentation into New Innovations' Residency Management Suite (RMS) and that hospitals are able to access and rely on accurate and consistent information in RMS.
