DOCUMENT NAMING STANDARDS

Looking for a particular document in a trainee's personnel file? Make things easier on yourself (and others who have access to that record) and make sure you are using the [standard naming guidelines](#). When these guidelines are used, finding a document will be a breeze.

When uploading a document that is not listed on the standard naming document, please give it a unique name that is going to help you (and others) know what they are about to click on. DO NOT name your documents "document1", "document2", "document3", etc. Save yourself time and stress by following these guidelines.
