REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION (Residency Permit)

Required documentation are mandatory documents approved by the MMCGME Board of Directors. The documentation is collected, stored and saved in resident/fellow RMS Program files.

Remember to save each document in the designated category sections within the personnel demographic page.

WHAT: Residency Permits - required for all training residents and fellows without a current MN Medical License.

SAVE WHERE: Personnel → Demographics → Permits Link: Complete the **Description, Permit number, Active Dates** and **Notes** fields. Lastly, Select the Choose File link → Scan, upload, and save Residency Permits details.
