

New Innovations Update

New Innovations has released a minor update to their Checklists module that will affect how residents "Changing Programs" are handled. This feature will now be called "Starting New Program" and will move from Advancement checklists to Onboarding checklists since the resident will be remaining with the institution in a different area of study rather than leaving for another opportunity. This change went live on Tuesday, August 29, and will not impact most users.

Portfolio Reviews Training

Per ACGME guidelines, residents need to be provided with a semiannual evaluation of their performance. The Portfolio Review module within RMS is a great way to gather information on your residents from multiple sources. In this training you will learn how:

- To set up semiannual reviews.
- To create form templates.
- RMS pulls information from Evaluations, Milestones, Procedure Logger, Schedules, Personnel, Curriculum, Duty Hours, Conferences, and Scholarly Activities to create a concise and robust resident review.
